



Assistant/Associate Program Director Emergency Medicine Residency Program

The Harvard Affiliated Emergency Medicine Residency (HAEMR) Program at Mass General Brigham is seeking an innovative educator to join our leadership team as an Assistant or Associate Program Director. HAEMR is a four-year training program with 60 residents. Residents split their time primarily between Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) and Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH) with other rotations at Boston Children's Hospital and Newton-Wellesley Hospital (community site). The program has a long history of training future academicians with many graduates pursuing fellowship training after graduation. Candidates must be Board Eligible or Board Certified in Emergency Medicine. In addition, the ideal candidate will have completed a fellowship in medical education and have previous experience in medical education as either a clerkship director or assistant/associate program director. New fellowship graduates will also be considered.

The candidate should have a demonstrated commitment to teaching, curriculum design and education scholarship. The successful candidate will join a motivated residency leadership team which consists of the Program Director, four other APDs, a program manager and two program coordinators. The Department of Emergency Medicine at Mass General Brigham Department is under the leadership of the Department Chair as well as Deputy Chairs at Massachusetts General Hospital and Brigham and Women's Hospital.
